### 5 Venues

(1) Tanabe Central Gymnasium : Tanabe venue

(19 Tanabe Maruyama, Kyotanabe City, Kyoto 610-0331)

(2) Kyoto Prefectural Yamashiro Sports Park Gymnasium (Taiyogaoka) : Uji venue (1 Hachikenyadani, Hironocho, Uji City, Kyoto 611-0031)

\*All the matches will be held throughout the day in the same venue.

#### 6 Competition Capacities

- (1) Competitive : Men 24 teams, Women 12 teams
- (2) Recreational : Men 28 teams, Women 12 teams

Each team, a minimum of seven athletes needs to be registered, with a maximum of 16 athletes and one team manager per team. Each team can register a maximum of four officials, including a team manager. Team managers are eligible to participate in the events as players. The maximum number of members (athletes and officials) per team is 20.

#### 7 Rules and Method of Competition

(1) Competition Rules

All events will be conducted in accordance with the competition rules of the Japan Handball Association, or as otherwise specified in this document.

(2) Technical Delegate

- (3) Competition Rule
  - A minimum of 3 matches will be played per team in all the categories.
  - The competition will be divided into two categories consisting of the competitive event and the recreational event.
  - The competitive event is divided into two age categories and the recreational

event is divided into three age categories.

- Teams are divided into men and women.
- In the competitive event, four men's teams will play in a league match format and will play in a tournament format as necessary to decide the ranking from the 1st to the 8th place. This is conducted in two age categories. In the meantime, three women's teams will play in a league match format and will play in a tournament format as necessary to decide the ranking from the 1st to the 6th place. This is conducted in two age categories.
- In the competitive event, medals will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd-ranked teams.
- In the recreational event, four men's teams and four women's teams will play in a league match format, respectively. This is conducted in three age categories.
- The organiser may change the competition schedule and venues when the number of applications is few and the competition cannot be held for certain category.
- The organiser will provide referees and scorers in all matches.

#### 8 Events

\*An athlete can compete in a younger age group.

\*The age of youngest registered team member determines which age category the team will compete in.

#### 9 Eligibility

Nothing in particular

In the competitive event, no individual application for participation is allowed.

In the recreational event, individual application for participation is allowed. The members of each team will be decided by the organiser.

Athletes can only participate in either the competitive event or the recreational event, but not in both.

#### 10 Age Requirement

Minimum age is 30 (born on or before 31 December 1992) In line with the sport-specific rules, an athlete must compete in their designated age group, with your age determined as at 31 December 2022. For example, if you are 39 during Games time but have turned 40 by 31 December 2022, you could compete in the 40+ age category.

## 11 Medal Ceremony

In the competitive event, the Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third-ranked men's and women's teams by age category.

# 12 Registration Fee

(1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

- ① Competition participants (Basic fee: allowed to participate in 5 disciplines)
  - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen/person
    (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
  - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen/person
    (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
  - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen/person (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
  - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen/person
    (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- (2) Additional charges (extra fee) None
- (3) Rental fee for competition equipment, etc.None (Competition equipment will not be rented.)

# 13 How to Apply for Participation

Application is made through the entry system on the official website (Entry System) dedicated to the application for the entry to the competition via PC or smartphone.

# 14 Notes on Participation

(1) Clothing

Players of the same team must wear the same uniform.

The goalkeeper must wear a uniform that can be distinguished from that of the court players and that of the goal keeper of the opposing team.

Athletes must wear indoor shoes at designated places such as on the gymnasium floor.

(2) Competition equipment

The organiser will provide the competition equipment, including the balls, goals, goal nets and the like.

(3) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

- (4) Doping Control
  - ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the</u> <u>rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
  - ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters</u> <u>Games Association</u>.
  - ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with <u>the rules of the International Masters Games</u> <u>Association</u> upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> Rules for more details.
  - ④ This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean athletes in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.
- (5) Procedure for Bad Weather

If a weather warning is issued and a disaster is predicted to occur or transportation is expected to be suspended, the competition may be cancelled.

# **15** Application for Accommodation and Transportation

(1) Accommodation

(2) Transportation

The organiser will not arrange accommodation or transportation, but related information is available on the website exclusive to the handball competition. The shuttle bus connecting the nearest station (Kintetsu Shin Tanabe Station / JR Kyotanabe Station) to Tanabe Central Gymnasium and the shuttle bus connecting the Tanabe Central Gymnasium with the Yamashiro Sports Park Gymnasium are available free of charge.

## 16 Others

All participants must complete the Games accreditation process and Sport check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the Temporary Accreditation Venue. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, even when participating in team competitions or as a team, each participant must complete accreditation process.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.

- b) For team athletes, a team representative can sport check-in as a team by confirming the other team members.
- c) Individual athletes must sport check-in by yourselves.
- d) Please bring your Accreditation Card which will be provided at the games accreditation for sport check-in.

## (3)Official Training

On Friday, 13 May, each venue will be open for training and on Saturday morning, 14 May, only Yamashiro Sports Park Gymnasium will be open for training. No application is required. Since reservations are not accepted, each

person must take turns and use the venue. There is also a shuttle bus service available. For details, please refer to the Games website.
