7 Competition Details

- (1) Competition Rules
 - All races will be conducted in accordance with the IOF Competition Rules and WMOC Manual.
- (2) Technical Delegate
 - Toshio Onoye, President, Hyogo Prefectural Orienteering Association
- (3) How to compete
 - This is an individual competition and interval start races will be used for the events. The fastest competitor will be the winner of the race. Competitors start at a time specified in the class at 1 or 2 minute intervals.
 - There are two types of format : Sprint competition held in the urban area and Forest competition held in the forest.
 - The Sprint competition consists of a Qualification race and a Final race.
 - The Forest competition consists of a Qualification race, a Middle Distance Final race and a Long Distance Final race.
 - Courses will be set to meet target winning times. The target winning times are as follows.

Sprint: 12 - 15 minutes

Forest Qualification: 35 – 50 minutes Middle Distance Final: 25 - 35 minutes Long Distance Final: 45 – 70 minutes,

The target winning times will be different for each age category, except Sprint.

• Based on the qualification races, the qualifiers will be split into A-final, B-final and so on in each age category. Details will be published in Bulletin 2 and on https://wmg2021-orienteering.jp/.

(4) Maps

- The maps are based on the IOF International Specification for Sprint Orienteering Maps, ISSprOM 2019, or the IOF International Specification for Orienteering Maps, ISOM 2017-2.
- Scale is 1:4,000 or 1:3,000 for Sprint maps and 1:10,000 and/or 1:7,500 for Forest maps.

(5) Punching system

- The SPORTident punching system will be used. Touch free mode (Air+) will be activated in addition to classic SPORTident punching. Both classical SIcard and SIAC for touch free can be used.
- These SI cards can be rented from the organisers.

9 Eligibility

(1) Age requirement: Minimum age is 35 (born on or before 31 December 1987)

10 Medal Ceremony

 WMG2021 medals for each age category will be awarded for 1st, 2nd and 3rd at the A-finals.

11 Registration Fee

- (1) Competition participation fee (including tax and handling fee)

 - a) Overseas participants: 24,000 yen per person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 15,000 yen per person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
 - ② Persons related to the competition (Basic fee)
 - a) Overseas participants: 14,000 yen per person
 (Including a transportation pass for mobility within the Kansai area.)
 - b) Domestic participants: 5,000 yen per person
 (Does not include a transportation pass. Could be bought optionally at an additional cost.)
- (2) Rental fees of competition equipment and options
 - ① Rental fee of SI-card
 - When booking in advance until 10 April 2022:
 - 1,000 yen per entire period for classical SI-Card
 - 2,000 yen per entire period for SIAC
 - When booking on or after 11 April 2022:
 - 300 yen per day or 1,500 yen per entire period for classical SI-Card 700 yen per day or 3,000 yen per entire period for SIAC

14 Notes on Participation

- (1) Embargoed areas
 - Competitors must not enter embargoed areas for orienteering purposes that have been announced by the organiser.

(2) Clothing

- All competitors must wear a numbered bib on the chest (both chest and back for sprint).
- Although there are no particular restrictions on clothing, competitors are recommended to wear long sleeves and pants for forest competitions.
- For shoes, the use of metal stud shoes and spikes is prohibited in sprint competitions.
- (3) Competition equipment, etc.
 - With regards to competition equipment, competitors can carry the map, control descriptions provided by the organiser and SI card (including rental), watches and compasses.
 - Competitors are not allowed to use communication equipment during the competition. GPS-enabled devices (smartwatches etc.) can be carried provided that they have no map display and are not used for navigation purposes.
 - The SPORTident punching system is used for the competition. Competitors
 must prepare an SI card to be used for punching and register the card
 number on the WMG entry website in advance. Those who do not have an
 SI card can rent one from the organiser.

(4) Insurance

The organiser will subscribe to accident insurance for participants, but this insurance is applicable only to "injuries incurred during the competition in the competition venues" of the "competition participants and persons related to the competition", and does not cover all kinds of risks during the competition. Therefore, all persons taking part in the competition are requested to subscribe to required insurance at own risk and costs.

(5) Doping Control

- ① The doping control in accordance with the <u>World Anti-Doping Code</u> and <u>the rules of the International Masters Games Association</u> shall apply to this competition.
- ② Anti-doping activities (doping inspections and anti-doping education activities) shall be conducted in accordance with the rules of the International Masters Games Association.
- ③ Participants are deemed to have agreed to be subject to doping control procedures in accordance with the rules of the International Masters Games Association upon entry to the competition. Participants are advised to check the rules of the International Masters Games Association Rules for more details.
- This competition aims to promote anti-doping activities as an activity to protect clean sports and clean competitors in order to leave various values of sports to the next generation through sports in cooperation with the Japan Anti-Doping Agency.

(6) Procedure for Bad Weather

- If a weather warning is issued and it is considered that the safety of competitors and transportation access cannot be secured, the competition may be cancelled.
- In the case where the competition venue becomes unusable due to a natural disaster (storm, fire, etc.) or an emergency situation, the organiser must endeavor to hold the competition at a reserve competition venue.

Wide area transportation

A direct bus is scheduled to operate from the sprint competition area (Kobe City) to the forest competition area (Tajima region), and you can board by showing your AD card.

2 Shuttle bus in the forest area

During the forest competition, a shuttle bus will be operated between the Yabu Event Center, the railway station, the sub-base near the

accommodation, and each competition venue.

16 Others

All participants must complete the accreditation process and check-in at the competition venue before participating (competing or getting involved) in a competition.

(1) Games Accreditation

Accreditation services shall be provided at the Opening Village, each Prefectural Masters Village, Center Village, and the special service desks. The participant must bring a valid photo identification and complete accreditation process personally by one day before the competition. (No exception will not be allowed.) Furthermore, each participant must complete accreditation process, even if they are entered in a group.

Accreditation process can be completed at any of designated service desks; however, operation hours and dates differ depending on the location.
